Wombat's City Hostel Vienna

Wombat's City Hostel Vienna Naschmarkt is located in a highly attractive area where Vienna has everything to offer that makes the city so unique: artistic architecture meets hip scene meets multicultural ambience meets the pulse of the metropolis.

"Naschmarkt" is the name of Vienna's largest food market. Here you can not only enjoy exotic spices, every imaginable specialty and international food in every price category, it is also a popular meeting place where a very mixed crowd treats itself to a drink or two.

The City Hostel itself is housed in an art nouveau building from the early 20th century, where the modern rooms - each with its own bathroom - are located behind the historic façade on five floors (with an elevator, of course).

The in-house WomCAFÉ (with its own Wombat's Roast!) and the legendary WomBAR might tempt you not to leave the building at all - but the good things are so close! A walk across the Naschmarkt takes you directly to the famous Secession building and on to Karlsplatz. From there, it's just a stone's throw to the State Opera and the historic - and chic - center of Vienna. The U4 subway stops just a few meters from the hostel.

Wombat's City Hostel Vienna Naschmarkt hosts a total of 123 rooms with 492 beds, including private rooms and female only rooms.

Founded by former backpackers Marcus Praschinger and Sascha Dimitriewicz in 1999 in Vienna, Wombat's has become an integral part of the backpacker scene with locations in several countries, a loyal community, and numerous awards. Wombat's has won the "HOSCAR Award" for best international hostel chain 7 times and has been named "Most Popular Hostel" more than 20 times in various cities over the years. Wombat's City Hostels in Vienna, Munich (at Hauptbahnhof and at Werksviertel), London, and Budapest now collectively host an average of 300,000 overnight stays per year.
